The event is for advanced solo drivers only and not limited to just Porsches. We recommend that cars be equipped with DOT "R" tires. However, street tires may be used if rated for speeds of 149 mph or higher (V, W, Y, or Z). Tires must be new or nearly new. Boxsters and other late model Porsche convertibles (996/997) may participate with tops up. We strongly recommend that all cars have a roll bar or full cage. Cars must have a technical inspection at an approved shop. We also recommend the use of a harness, a HANS device, and PCA endorsed track insurance (available at www.pcahpdeins.locktonaffinity.com).
